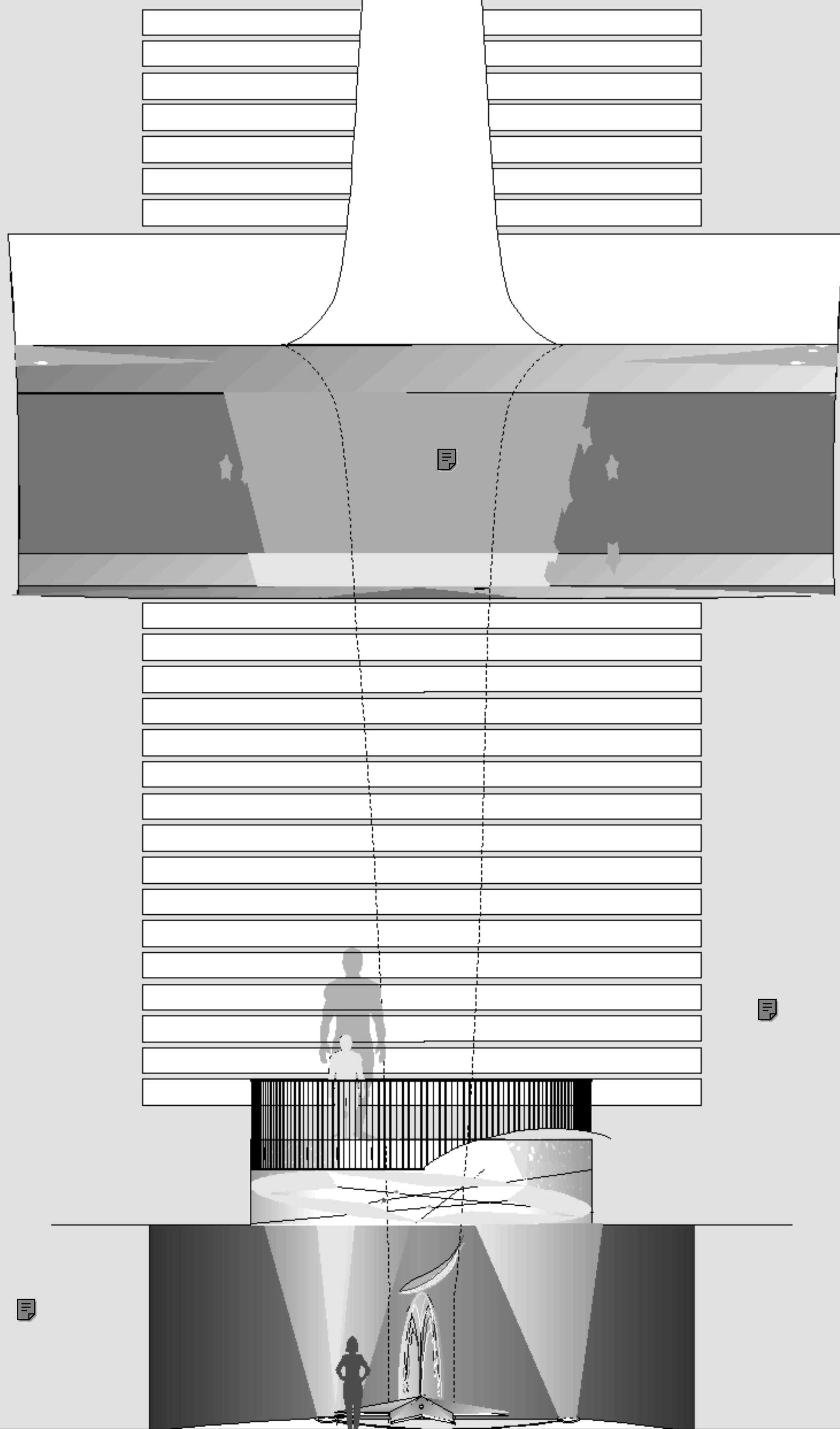
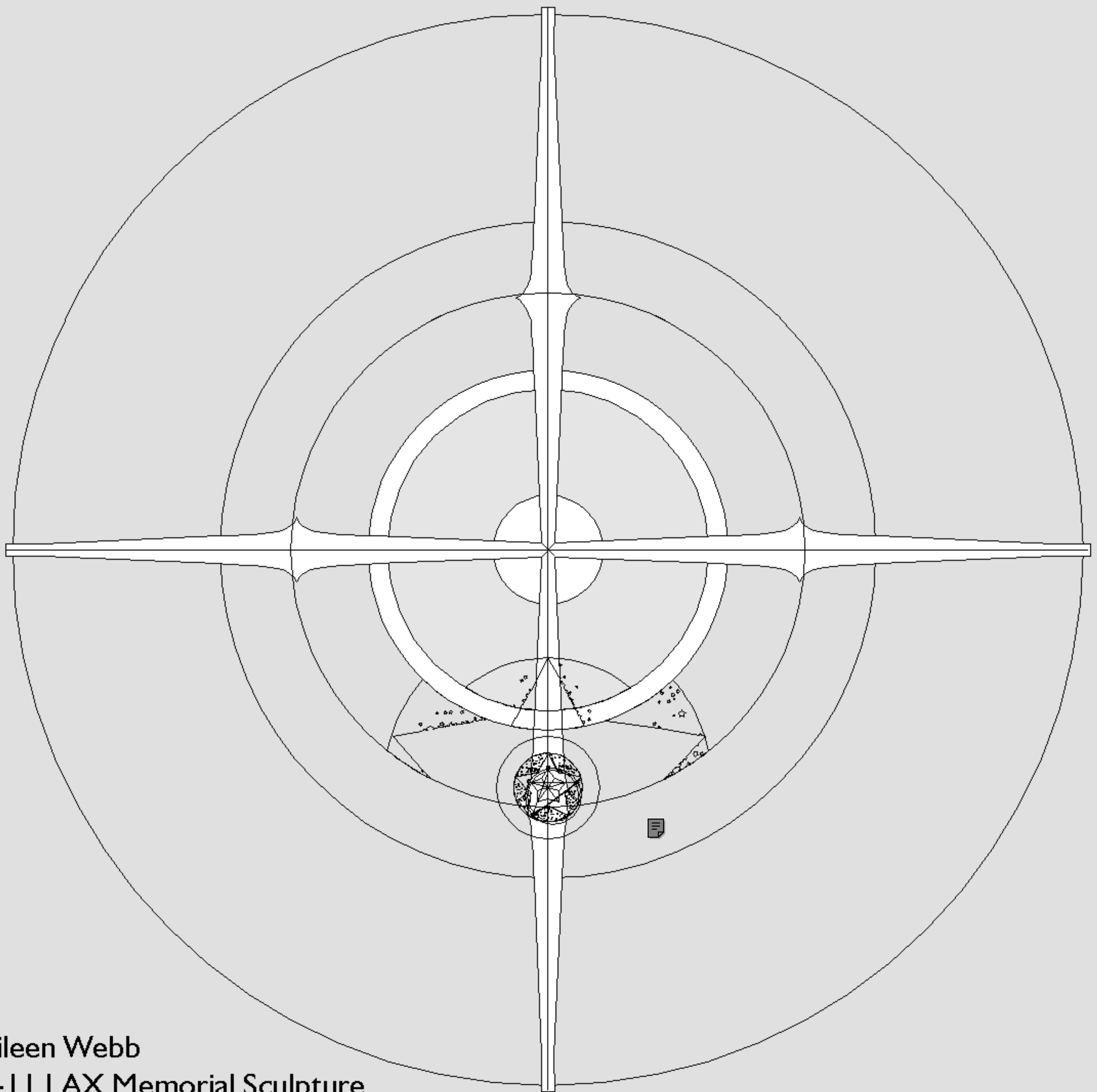

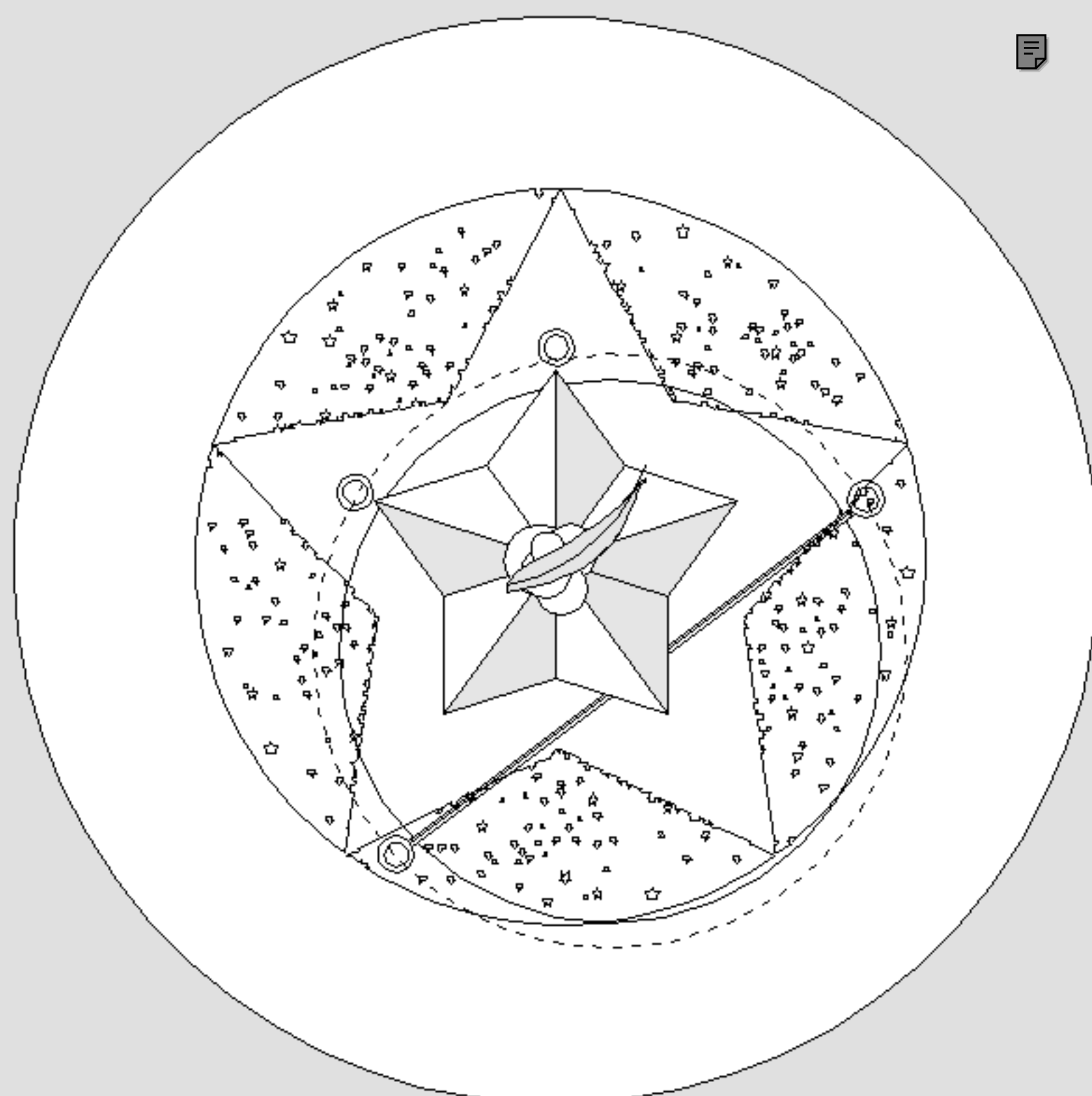

cutaway view w/ all elements

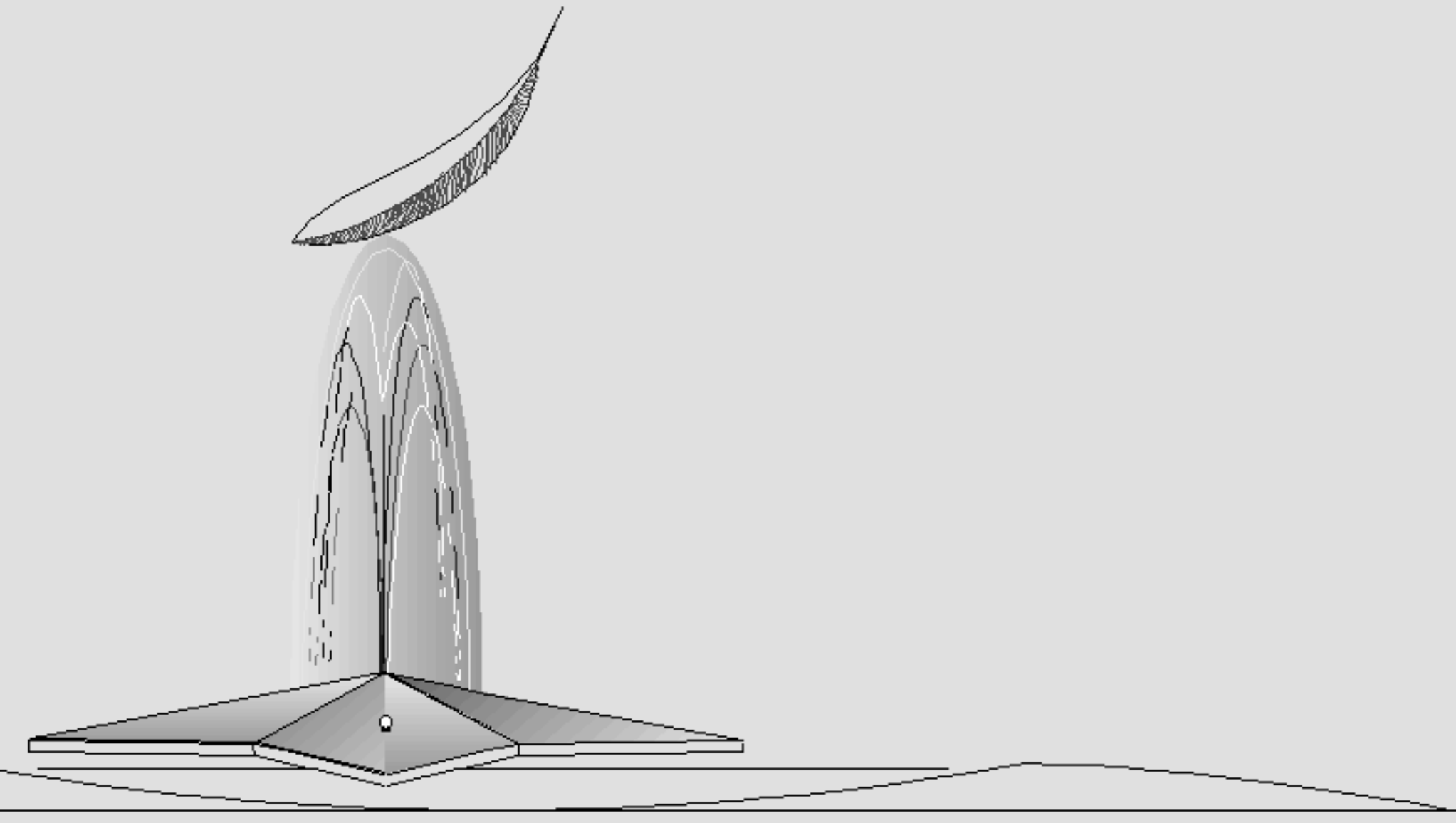
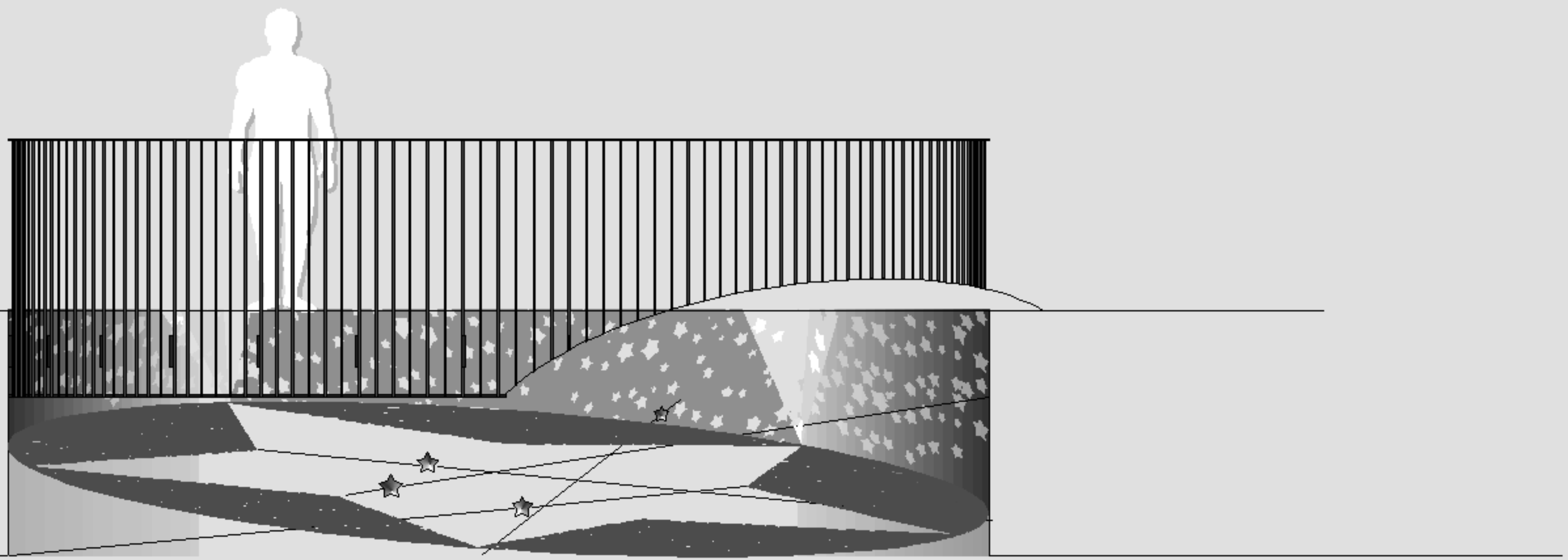

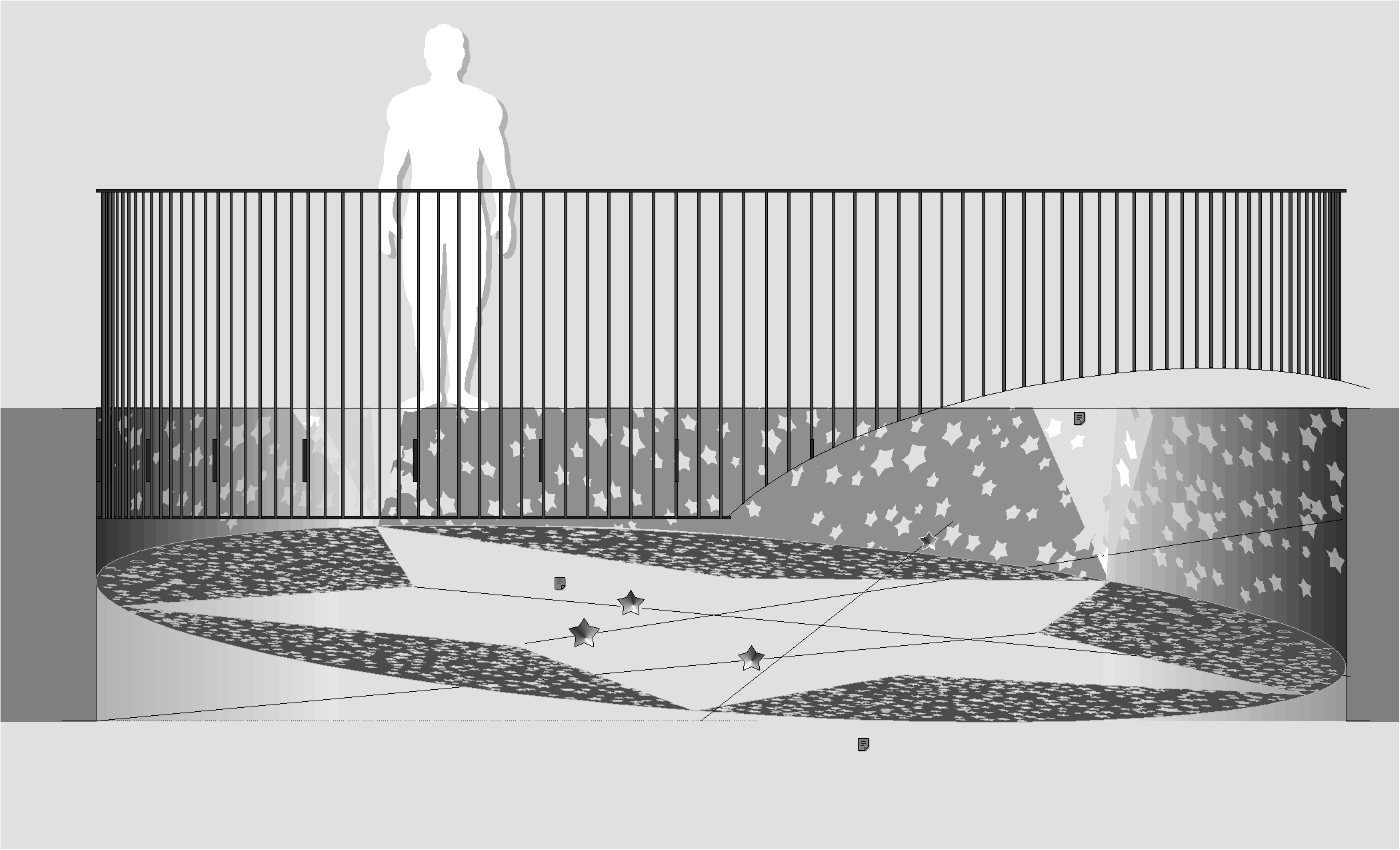
